



Parents/Spectators Code of Conduct



We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in football. Regional Sports Football Academy is implementing a code of conduct to ensure that the football is played in a safe, secure and positive environment.

While you are with us at the academy your children's football is a time for them to develop their basic or advanced technical, tactical, physical & mental skills as well as their social skills. WINNING isn't everything. It is a place for the players to learn.

- Please play your part and observe the Regional Sports Football Academy code of conduct for parents & spectators at all times.
- The decisions of match officials and coaches must not be questioned. Do not ever get involved in any argument with match officials, opposing players or staff and their supporters. Encouragement should be given to players to do the same.
- Please stay at a reasonable distance away from the playing area for training and matches.
- You may comment positively on play (e.g. 'well done') but please keep quiet regarding mistakes that are made. Mistakes are all part of a player's learning. The ONLY coaching that should take place will be the responsibility of the team coaches and senior coaching staff.
- Applaud good play as well as success.
- Please ensure your child arrives ON TIME to every training session and matches (ideally 15 minutes before).
- Please abide by any rules displayed at any training facility or match venue e.g no smoking, no littering etc
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour

Failure to comply/adhere with the above may result in the player/parent being asked to leave the training session, match or academy
